
INTERVAL IN TIME OVERVIEW

The Interval in Time study is a detailed look at the prophetic patterns found in history and how they can inform the future. This brief overview looks at the two charts that are the foundation of this study, along with a brief explanation of the components of the charts and the implications for the near future.

THE CHART IN PART 1 gives the dates of events in BC, an interval of 2,520 years (or 2483.8 years on our solar calendar), an interval given in Ezekiel 4:4-6, and then the corresponding dates in AD. (see Part 1 pg.5)

A This chart forms the paleo Hebrew letter **Chet**. Its pictural meaning is to separate, to fence in, to protect. This prophetic pattern is separated from any other historical period or pattern; It is unique in all the thousands of years of history.



- (BC 612, 606/5, and 597 do not have an AD date that corresponds in theme.)
- BC 587: the Kingdom of Judah is conquered; Jerusalem and the Temple are destroyed.
 AD 1897: the first Zionist congress meets with the goal of re-establishing the Jewish State.
- BC 539: Babylon is conquered by Media -Persia. AD 1945: Germany is conquered by the Allies, USA, England, USSR.
- BC 537/6: **Aug.3** Persian ruler Cyrus issues decree freeing the Jews and allowing them to return to Judea.

AD – 1947/8: The Jews return to the land of Israel and re-establish the Jewish State on May 14, 1948 exactly 2,483.8 years later.

- BC 518: Aug.15 Darius issues decree giving the Jews control of the site of the Temple.
 AD –1967: Israel liberates the Temple Mount and unites Jerusalem during the Six Day War on June 7, 1967 exactly 2,483.8 years later.
- BC 465: Artaxerxes 1 becomes king of Persia, 'the King of the World' AD – 2017: Donald J. Trump becomes President of the USA.

2018: moves the US embassy to Jerusalem, recognizing Jerusalem as Israel's capital. 2020: the Abraham Accords are signed, the beginnings of peace in the Middle-East.

BC – 457: Artaxerxes 1 re-issues the decree of Cyrus to Ezra, to rebuild the Temple and teach the law of God. Daniel 9:25 states that from the issuing of the decree until the coming of the Messiah is 69 weeks (483 years)

AD - 27: Jesus the Messiah is baptized 483 years after Ezra receives the decree. AD – 2027

BC – 445: **March 14,** Artaxerxes 1 gives letters to Nehemiah allowing him to go to Judah and rebuild the city of Jerusalem. Using the text from Daniel 9:25, 283 years (476 years on the solar calendar) the Messiah will come and die.

AD – 32: exactly 476 years later, Jesus the Messiah dies on April 12 (14 Nisan - Passover), 32AD

AD - 2040

Only our God and Savior, who knows the end from the beginning, could have created this unique historical pattern which stretches across more than two thousand years.

THE CHART IN PART 2 consists of six columns: (1) the solar year (2) the Hebrew year (3) the Metonic Cycle (4) the 70 Shavuot (5) the Shmita cycle (6) the Song of Moses.

In the Interval in Time study each of the columns are described and the significance of the important dates explained. It is too much to go over in this short overview, so I'll just point out a few interesting things.

First, is the symmetry, between the beginning and end of each column:

1-2) **1967** *<u>5727</u> is the beginning date on the chart. On June 7, during the Six-Day War, Jerusalem and the Temple Mount came under Israeli sovereignty.*

2043 5803 is the end date. We don't know the future but if we follow the 6+1 pattern, after the

Six-Day War this would be the 7th day, the day of rest. Jerusalem would be at peace.

- 3) The Metonic Cycle **begins and ends** with the 7th year of the Cycle.
- 4) The **first** Feast of Shavuot was on June 15, 1967 and the **last** Feast of Shavuot will be on June 15, 2043. There are 77 Shavuot.
- 5) The Shmita Cycle begins with a Jerusalem Jubilee and ends with the 11th Shmita year: The land will be at rest, debts cancelled, slaves set free, and the poor cared for. The 6+1 pattern of six years of work and one day of rest is followed.
- 6) The **first** verse on the chart, Deut.31:2-3, states that Moses is 120 years old. In the **last** verse, Deut.32:48 (-50), the LORD instructs Moses to go up to Mount Nebo and die Moses is 120.

A second interesting thing is that the 19-year Metonic Cycle, the 70 Shavuot, and 10 Shmita cycles are all **completed** in the same year, **2035/6** *5796*. The verse for this year is Deut.32:41, the verse/year the **LORDS vengeance begins**.

Each of these cycles also has interesting markers:

Historically, the 19th year of **the Metonic cycle** is the end of one era and the beginning of another. (See Part 2 pg.3)

Is the year 2036 the end of the era of grace and the beginning of judgment?

The **70 Shavuot** begins in 1967, when, after nearly 2,000 years, Israel re-gained sovereignty over the Temple Mount and a <u>large plaza</u> was created in front of the Kotel, the Western Wall, so that the Jewish people could worship. Daniel 9:25 (see Part 2 pg.4)

Is the year 2036 when the 'beast that rises out of the pit', rules over Jerusalem for 42 months, and kills the two witnesses? Is the Kotel Plaza, which can be viewed 24/7 via the internet, where people around the world will 'gaze on their dead bodies'? Rev.11

There are two other interesting dates in the Shavuot column:

The first is **2027/28.** This is the end date of the decree given to Ezra (457 BC + 2483.8 yrs. = 2027/28 AD) 457 BC is the date of the decree, which by adding the 483 years of Daniel 9:26, ends with the baptism of the Messiah in 27 AD.

The second date is **2034/35**, which is the 69th Shavuot or week. It is after the 69th week that Daniel 9:26 foretells the death of the Messiah **to the exact day**: April 12, AD 32 *(Passover: 14 Nisan 3792)* (See Amazing Prophecies Part 1 pg.12)

Will either of these dates be significant in the future? Could these dates indicate, when the Messiah comes again, or conversely, when the so-called anti-Christ appears? These two dates are seven years apart, or two 3 ½ year periods. Interesting.

The Shmita cycle is a historic pattern unlike any other, and it was instituted by God Himself. We can see historically that the 7th year of the Shmita cycle marks economic hardship or disaster. (See Part 2 pg.9) It has also marked years of the rise and fall of empires and the rise of Islamic power. (Part 2 pg.10).

Within the 7-year Shmita cycle is a 49-year cycle. This is called the Super Shmita Cycle. Every 7th Shmita year is a **Super Shmita** year.

A regular Shmita year is when the Hebrew year can be evenly divided by 7, e.g. $2022 = 5782 \div 7 = 826$. A super Shmita year is when the Hebrew year can be evenly divided by 49, e.g. $2022 = 5782 \div 49 = 118$. Historically in those years the geo-political world changes.

2022 is a Super Shmita year and we are already seeing the shaking of the nations. Is this the beginning of the promised shaking?

Israel Today magazine stated: "We are once again in the midst of a major shaking of our institutions in fulfilment of many ancient prophecies, including Haggai 2:6 and Hebrews 12:26." [July14,2022]

When God spoke from Mount Sinai his voice shook **the earth**, but now he makes another promise: "Once again **I will shake** not only the **earth** but the **heavens** also." _{Heb.12:26}

"This is what the LORD Almighty says: 'In a little while I will once more shake the heavens and the earth, the sea and the dry land. " $_{
m Haggai\,2:6}$

The prophetic pattern found in history, indicates that what happens in the Shmita year sets the stage for the following 7-year Shmita cycle. That means that all the events that have begun in 2022 will most likely continue and intensify during the coming Shmita interval or cycle.

-The War in the Ukraine may be setting the stage for WWIII

-The economic crises, including inflation rates at a forty-year high may become a global depression. -The global (man-made) food shortages may become a world-wide famine.

-The dissolution of governments and political upheaval may lead to new global power structure. Or, the nations will repent and God responds with compassion and mercy.

The 6th column, the Song of Moses, begins with the 5,727th verse in the Bible, Deuteronomy 31:3. This verse is the same number as the Hebrew year of *5727*, or 1967 on the solar calendar. The Song of Moses begins in Deut.32:1 and corresponds to the year 1996. (See Part 2 pg.18)

The Song of Moses summarizes Gods relationship with His people. In verse 27, the verse that corresponds to the year **2022**, God gives His reason for canceling Israels' just punishment and indicts Israels' enemies instead.

Deut.32:27⁵⁷⁸²⁻²⁰²² * had I not feared provocation by the enemy, lest their ^{Israels} adversaries should misunderstand, lest they should say 'Our hand is triumphant, it was not the LORD who did all this.'

The year **3024/2035** is the year of the 69th Shavuot and corresponds to Deut.32:40 For I lift up My hand to heaven and swear, As I live forever... which in turn corresponds to Revelation 10:5-6 And the angel whom I saw standing on the sea and on the land raised his right hand to heaven and swore by Him who lives forever and ever, who created heaven and what is in it, the earth and what is in it, and the sea and what is in it, that the interval in time would be over [HCSB] there would be no more delay [ESV] ...

The year 2035/36 *5796* **is the year of completion**. This is the year when the **19**-year Metonic Cycle, the **70** Shavuot, and the **10**th Shmita cycle have all reached the end of their cycles during the same year. The corresponding verse is: Deut.32:41 *if I sharpen My flashing sword and My hand takes hold on judgment, I will take vengeance on My adversaries and will repay those who hate Me.*

The Interval in Time has ended and the days of the LORDS vengeance have begun.

If my understanding of the pattern of dates, times, cycles and the Song of Moses is correct, many of us will see the sign of His coming and the close of the age. $_{Matt.24:3}$

I am often asked, "What do I do now?"

If you are a believer, a follower of Y'shua Jesus, keep living your life, with Him leading you, as you have been but with the awareness that this age may soon come to a close. Don't put your head in the sand or be preoccupied with the future. Be ready for what Scripture tells us will come, but continue to trust in the LORD and He will direct your path so that you will be ready to do the work that God has already prepared for you to do. Eph.2:8-10, Proverbs 3:5-6

Strengthen your faith. Read your Bible. Pray for understanding and discernment so that you will not be led astray by false teachers. Matthew 24:4-5, 11, 23-24

Pray for protection and provision, for the days of lawlessness are coming. Matthew 24:12 Only God knows the day or the hour and, in the meantime, He needs every one of us to do our part in the here and now.

Let us be like Issachar, who had understanding of the times, to know what to do. 1Chr.12:32 Let us pray for wisdom so that we can understand. Dan.12:10 Col.1:9-14
